

IN CASE OF A MAJOR EARTHQUAKE

- Protect yourself from collapsing and falling objects. Stay calm and wait for the tremor to stop.
- 2 Open the doors, check evacuation routes and emergency exits. Do not use elevators.
- 3 Extinguish fire. If a fire breaks out, work in a group to extinguish it as soon as possible.
- 4 If someone is injured, work together to rescue them and move them to a safer place.
- 5 Move to the designated evacuation area and report your safety.
